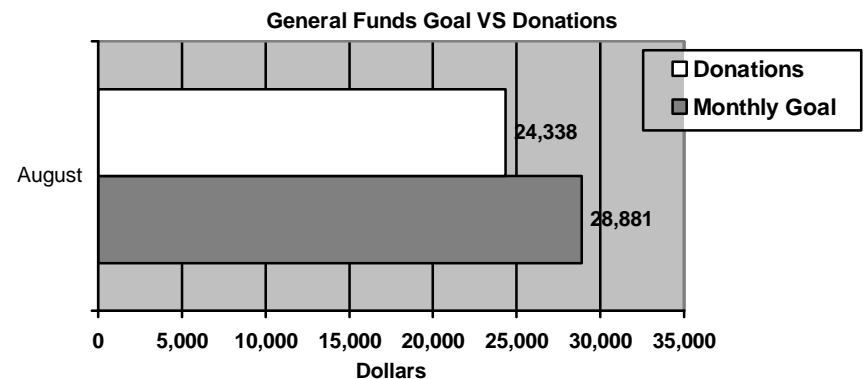
There was an insert in last Sunday’s bulletin which sets up a time line in preparation for our meeting. Please refer to it, or contact the office if you would like one mailed out to you.
